4. Principal's report – Janet  
Need parents for Graduation Committee. Submit email to Janet and she will forward to Mrs. Barnett.

Moya still needs to be reimbursed for the printing of last years Magazine, but is waiting for the printer to give her a receipt to submit. On Demand Printing, 562-941-8420. 6. Teacher's report – Taiz Nadjarians  
Will be doing teacher portraits and she purchased the frames for 23-26 teachers. She will provide PTSO with a receipt.  
*Portraits on Display* will be in April sometime. Students will donate food this year, she will purchase flowers.  
There are a few new teachers who won't go into the show this year, but they will go in next year.

A motion was made by Janet to pay the entire amount of the frames for \$303.72.

We can display them in various places on the campus until the new school is built, possibly the teacher's room. If the teacher leaves, they can take their portraits, but leave the frame. Ms. Nadjarians will collect them all at the end of the year for storage until school begins again in the fall.

There was a concern that since we don't have a permanent location at this time that we wait until we are going to hang permanently.

Janet amended the motion to reimburse Ms. Nadjarians for the frames up to \$225. Purchase frames for advanced students only. Charleen 2nd the motion, approved.
